RESOLUTION 89-95

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE RAILBELT ENERGY FUND FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer believes that the Railbelt Energy Fund is earmarked for distribution to communities within the railbelt, and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the Railbelt Energy Fund consisting of \$229,000,000 be distributed during fiscal year 1991 to support economic development and energy improvements for communities within the railbelt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that an appropriation of \$135,000,000 be made from the Railbelt Energy Fund to the Alaska Energy Authority for the Healy to Fairbanks transmission line, Seward to Lawing as well as a new line between Soldotna and Anchorage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the remainder of the Railbelt Energy Fund be shared among the Municipalities within the railbelt resulting in long-term economic development benefits including the following Capital Improvements/Legislative requests for the City of Homer:

- Replace State Harbor Floats \$1,500,000
- 2. Sterling Highway RV Park/Visitor Ctr 247,000
- 3. Port 30 Acre Sewer/Water Utility 450,000
- 4. Pratt Museum Renovation/Expansion Compl 90,200

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise the Governor, Legislature, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities as well as the Kenai Peninsula Borough of the above project intended for long-term economic development benefits.
