A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
AWARDING THE 1993 ARP PAVING PROJECT ARP-21  
NUMBER 300121 TO THE FIRM OF ALASKA ROAD  
BUILDERS OF SOLDOTNA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO  
EXCEED \$289,062 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the invitation to bid for the 1993 ARP Paving Project  
ARP 21 Number 300121 was advertised in the Homer News, Peninsula  
Clarion and the Anchorage Daily News on April 15, 22 and 29, 1993;  
and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were due by 2:00 p.m. on May 6, 1993, in  
the Homer City Clerk's Office located at the Homer City Hall; and


WHEREAS, two (2) sealed bids were received by the City Clerk,  
date and time stamped, and a public bid opening was held in the  
Council Chambers of the Homer City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Alaska Road Builders of Soldotna  
submitted the lowest responsive bid in the amount of \$289,062, Base  
Bid.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Homer City Council  
awards the bid for the 1993 ARP Paving Project ARP 21 Number 300121  
to the firm of Alaska Road Builders of Soldotna in an amount not to  
exceed \$289,962 Base Bid and authorizes the City Manager to sign  
the appropriate documents.
