RESOLUTION 94-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF HOMER, ALASKA, AMENDING THE HOMER ADVISORY
PLANNING COMMISSION BYLAWS

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission operates under a set of bylaws approved and set forth by the Homer City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission has the authority to adopt or amend procedural rules subject to approval by the Homer City Council; and

WHEREAS, The Homer Advisory Planning Commission has reviewed and approved the following changes to the Bylaws.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council that the Homer Advisory Planning Commission Bylaws be amended as follows:

1. Paragraph A is amended to read: To abide by existing Alaska State law, Borough Code of Ordinance, where applicable, and Homer City Municipal Code pertaining to planning and zoning functions;
2. Paragraph B is amended to read: To abide by Robert's Rules of Order, 7th-Edition, in so far as this treatise is consistent with Homer City Municipal Code;
3. Paragraph H is amended to read: Quorum; Voting:

Four Commission members shall constitute a quorum. Four affirmative votes are required for the passage of a resolution or motion. Conditional use permits and zoning variances require a majority plus one vote. Voting will be by verbal vote, the order to be rotated. The final vote on each resolution or motion is a recorded roll call vote. For purposes of notification to parties of interest in a matter brought before the Commission, the Chairman shall enter for the record the vote and basis for determination.

The City Manager, or his designee, the Public Works Director and the Mayor shall serve as consulting members of the Commission but shall have no vote.

4. Paragraph M is amended to read: General Order of Business:
