

RESOLUTION 99-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA SUPPORTING THE ENACTMENT OF CHAPTER 8.10 OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH CODE, PROVIDING FOR LIMITED DOG CONTROL IN THE AREA OF THE BOROUGH OUTSIDE OF CITIES AND THE AGREEMENT CONCEPT; THAT THE CITY ATTORNEY REVIEW THIS AGREEMENT AND A LEGAL OPINION BE FORWARDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL PRIOR TO ANY FINAL DECISION.

WHEREAS, the Ordinance 98-76 was introduced on December 8, 1998 and is scheduled for public hearings on January 8 and 19, 1999; and

WHEREAS, Kenai Peninsula Assemblyman Drathman has requested input from the Homer City Council; and

WHEREAS, \$25,000 will be paid to the City of Homer for enforcement of this ordinance for an area of Ninilchik to Seldovia; and

WHEREAS, currently draft #2 agreement is the only one that has been provided to the City of Homer and no attachment 'A' - area, has been provided; and


WHEREAS, the Council is supportive of the concept of limited dog control out side of City Limits; and

WHEREAS, the Council directs that the City Attorney review this agreement and provide a legal opinion to the Council prior to any final decision of the Council regarding this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council supports the enactment of Chapter 8.10 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code, providing for Limited Dog Control in the area of the Borough outside of Cities and the agreement concept; and that the City Attorney review this agreement and a legal opinion be forwarded to the City Council prior to any final decision.
