

RESOLUTION 99-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA AWARDING THE CITY OF HOMER 1999 PUBLIC WORKS GRAVEL SUPPLY OF D-1 TO DIBBLE CREEK ROCK OF ANCHOR POINT, ALASKA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,500 (\$12.50/CY) FOR 600 CUBIC YARDS OF D-1 BASECOURSE; AND SAND & 2" MINUS TO PIT RUN PLUS OF NINILCHIK, ALASKA, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,900 (\$8.25/CY) FOR 1,200 CUBIC YARDS OF WINTER SAND AND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 (\$8.75/CY) FOR 400 CUBIC YARDS OF 2" MINUS GRAVEL AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the invitation to bid was advertised in the Homer News May 13 and 20, 1999 and posted on the City's Home Page; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were due in the Office of the City Clerk by 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 27, 1999; and

WHEREAS, four sealed bids were received with Dibble Creek Rock of Anchor Point submitting the lowest responsive bid for D-1 basecourse in the amount of \$7,500 (\$12.50/cy) for 600 cubic yards and Pit Run Plus, of Ninilchik, Alaska submitting the lowest responsive bid for Winter Sand in the amount of \$9,900 (\$8.25/cy) for 1,200 cubic yards and for the 2" minus gravel in the amount of \$3,500 (\$8.75/cy) for 400 cubic yards; and

WHEREAS, the award is not final until written notification is received by Dibble Creek Rock and Pit Run Plus by the City of Homer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska awards the City of Homer 1999 Public Works Gravel Supply of D-1 to Dibble Creek Rock of Anchor Point, Alaska in the amount of \$7,500 (\$12.50/cy) for 600 cubic yards of D-1 basecourse; and Sand & 2" minus to Pit Run Plus of Ninilchik, Alaska, in the amount of \$9,900 (\$8.25/cy) for 1,200 cubic yards of winter sand and in the amount of \$3,500 (\$8.75/cy) for 400 cubic yards of 2" minus gravel and authorizing the City Manager to execute the appropriate documents
