

42 seven harbor projects of significant importance locally as required in the Harbor Facility
43 Grant Program; and

45 WHEREAS, Completion of these harbor facility [projects is all dependent on the 50%
46 match from the State of Alaska's Municipal Harbor Facility Grant Program; and

47

48 WHEREAS, During the last ten years the Municipal Harbor Facility Grant Program has
49 only been fully funded twice, creating a backlog of projects necessary to repair and replace
50 these former State-owned harbors in excess of \$100,000,000.

51

52 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, by this
53 Resolution, urges full funding in the amount of \$18,160,055 by the Governor and the Alaska
54 Legislature for the State of Alaska's Municipal Harbor Facility Grant Program in the FY 2017
55 State Capital Budget in order to ensure enhanced safety and economic prosperity among
56 Alaskan coastal communities.
