6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
7 AMENDING THE FY 2014 OPERATING BUDGET BY
8 APPROPRIATING ~~\$11,331.48~~ **\$10,890.54** FROM THE HOMER
9 ~~VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT RESERVE ACCOUNT~~
10 **GENERAL FUND BALANCE** FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF
11 LAPTOP COMPUTERS COMPATIBLE WITH WINDOWS 7 FOR
12 DATA COLLECTION, ANALYSIS, AND REPORTING
13 REQUIREMENTS.

15 WHEREAS, The Homer Volunteer Fire Department uses a computerized information
16 management system to collect data and comply with reporting requirements of protected
17 data; and
18

19 WHEREAS, Effective April 2014 Microsoft will stop supporting the Windows XP
20 operating system, eliminating security patches and fixes, making the laptops vulnerable to
21 hardware failures and security breaches; and
22

23 WHEREAS, Microsoft will replace the Windows XP operating system to Windows 7
24 necessitating the replacement of three rugged laptops with new models that will run Windows
25 7 to allow for the secure collection of data, analysis, and reporting of protected data.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

29 Section 1. The City Council hereby amends the FY 2014 Operating Budget by
30 appropriating ~~\$11,331.48~~ **\$10,890.54** from the ~~Homer Volunteer Fire Department Reserve~~
31 ~~Account~~ **General Fund Balance** for the replacement of laptop computers compatible with
32 Windows 7 for secure data collection, analysis, and reporting requirements as follows:
