

46 WHEREAS, Many other communities have been recently scored and are currently
47 eligible for Municipal Harbor Facility Grants; and
48

49 WHEREAS, All the money invested in these harbors by the State and matched by
50 communities stimulates the economy, creates safer and more functional harbors for residents and
51 for the fishing fleets and creates job opportunities for local residents and businesses, which is
52 especially important in these times of economic hardship.
53

54 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Homer urges full funding by
55 the Governor and the Alaska Legislature to support the Municipal Harbor Facility Grant Program
56 to ensure safety and economic prosperity among coastal communities.
