A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,  
APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE DONATION FROM THE  
BUNNELL STREET ARTS CENTER OF A FANCIFUL LOON  
WINDSOCK SCULPTURE BY ALASKAN ARTIST RACHELLE  
DOWDY TO BE PLACED AT BISHOP'S BEACH PARK.

WHEREAS, Bunnell Street Arts Center issued a Request for Proposals in conjunction  
with the Old Town Artist in Residency project for a new sculpture in Old Town; and

WHEREAS, Representatives of Bunnell Street Arts Center selected Alaskan Artist  
Rachelle Dowdy's art sculpture of a fanciful loon with a windsock to be placed at Bishop's  
Beach Park; and

WHEREAS, Rachelle Dowdy is a talented artist whose work is held in many public  
collections throughout the State of Alaska; her artwork is a fanciful loon sculpture with a  
windsock that provides an instant visual cue to the wind conditions; and

WHEREAS, Bunnell Street Arts Center would like to donate the artwork to the City's art  
collection and has completed the required application for the donation; and


WHEREAS, The Public Arts Committee has reviewed the request for donation to the
