RESOLUTION 14-102

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ENCOURAGING THE
ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES
TO FIX THE BUMPS ON THE EAST END BIKE PATH.

WHEREAS, East End Bike Path is an asset to Homer that is frequently used by
commuters and recreational cyclists; and

WHEREAS, Culverts have heaved along East End Bike Path creating dangerous bumps;
and

WHEREAS, Although these bumps have been painted yellow as a warning, they
routinely buck cyclists out of their saddle, sometimes resulting in crashes and injury; and

WHEREAS, The severity of the bumps forces many cyclists to the exposed shoulder of
East End Road defeating the purpose of a separated pathway; and


WHEREAS, Road construction work is currently underway to extend the East End Bike
Path and rehabilitate East End Road; and

WHEREAS, It would be cost efficient to take advantage of the current mobilization of
construction crews and repair the bumps in conjunction with the East End Road, Kachemak
Drive to Waterman Road project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska,
encourages the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to fix the
hazardous bumps on East End Bike Path as soon as possible.
