

39 WHEREAS, The proposed reduction to the budget for public radio seems
40 disproportionate and will adversely affect service across Alaska; especially to Bush and rural
41 residents where public radio may be the primary source of regional and emergency
42 information.

44 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska,
45 respectfully requests the Alaska Legislature consider less severe cuts to the Alaska Public
46 Broadcasting Commission in the FY17 budget.
