6 A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING AN
7 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE.
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9 WHEREAS, It is the responsibility of the City of Homer to make reasonable
10 accommodations in its services, activities, programs or benefits so they are accessible to
11 people with disabilities; and

13 WHEREAS, In accordance with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990
14 (ADA) local governments with 50 or more employees are required to adopt and publish
15 procedures for resolving grievances arising under Title II of the ADA; and
16

17 WHEREAS, Grievance procedures set out a system for resolving complaints of
18 disability discrimination in a prompt and fair manner; and
19

20 WHEREAS, The ADA Compliance Committee has reviewed the grievance policy to
21 ensure it includes-

- 22
- 23 • How and where a complaint under Title II may be filed with the City of Homer;
 - 24 • A statement notifying potential complainants that alternative means of filing
25 will be available to people who require such an alternative;
 - 26 • A description of time frames and processes to be followed by the complainant
27 and the City of Homer;
 - 28 • Information on how to appeal an adverse decision;
 - 29 • A statement of how long complaint files will be retained.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council adopts the City of
31 Homer ADA Grievance Procedure.


