

43 narrowly, so that the City cannot inform the public fully about the effects of the ballot
44 proposition to issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$12 million dollars
45 and increase the sales tax seasonally .65% April 1 through September 30 to pay debt service
46 without including information that APOC likely would categorize as influencing the outcome
47 of the election on the ballot proposition.
48

49 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:
50

51 Section 1. The City Council hereby appropriates funds from the Public Safety Building
52 Project Fund Balance to provide public information on the ballot proposition to issue General
53 Obligation Bonds Not To Exceed \$12 Million Dollars to finance the acquisition and
54 construction of a police station and provide for an increase in the rate of city sales tax from
55 4.5% to 5.15% from April 1 through September 30 with the increase providing funds to pay
56 debt service on the general obligation bonds and expiring on September 30 the year when the
57 city has received sufficient funds from the increase to pay all of that debt service, including
58 information that may influence the outcome of the election on the proposition.
