ORDINANCE 79-8

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL  
ELECTION, OCTOBER 2, 1979.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Homer City Code, Chapter 4, Elections, and Title 29, Alaska Statutes, Municipal Code, the regular municipal election is to be held annually on the first Tuesday in October,

THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. A general municipal election shall be held within the corporate limits of the City of Homer, Alaska, on October 2, 1979, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City the following propositions:

PROPOSITION NO. 1 - To Elect a Councilman for a one (1) year term on the Homer City Council.

PROPOSITION NO. 2 - To Elect a Councilman for a two (2) year term on the Homer City Council.

PROPOSITION NO. 3 - To Elect a Councilman for a three (3) year term on the Homer City Council.

PROPOSITION NO. 4 - To Elect a Councilman for a three (3) year term on the Homer City Council.


PROPOSITION NO. 5 - Shall the City of Homer fund, from City taxes, a portion of the operation and maintenance costs of the Pratt Museum, operated by the Homer Society of Natural History, beginning fiscal year 1980-81?

PROPOSITION NO. 6 - Shall the City of Homer enact a five (5) percent tax on hotel/motel rooms and other commercial sleeping accommodations for the first seven days of occupancy; the proceeds of which shall be appropriated annually by the Council for the promotion of the tourist industry?

Section 2. The City Clerk is authorized to place on the ballot any such propositions which shall be submitted in proper form by initiative or referendum petition or other legal procedures,

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to publish NOTICE OF ELECTION, attached, and made part of this ordinance, in accordance with the Homer City Code, Chapter 4, Elections, Sections 4-100.3 and 4-100.4.
