## ORDINANCE 80-16

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 7-300.5 MOORING RATES, IN ITS ENTIRETY AND REENACTING THE SECTION TO INCLUDE MOORING RATES FOR RESERVED AND TRANSIENT VESSELS ON THE BASIS OF SQUARE FOOTAGE, AND PROVIDING FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF TRANSIENT LENGTH DESIGNATIONS.

WHEREAS, vessel impact in the Homer Small Boat Harbor has become so intense that guarantees of vessel parking availability can not be given;

WHEREAS, the administration and the Port and Harbor Commission have met and discussed this matter, developing a cost intensive moorage schedule and program to minimize congestive vessel parking;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Homer Ordains:

Section 1. Section 7-300.5 MOORING RATES of the Homer City Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read:

Sec. 7-300.5. MOORING RATES. Any vessel utilizing the harbor for mooring shall be charged in accordance with the appropriate schedule below. Any vessel which does not have the reserved mooring shall pay in accordance with the transient schedule and may pay the transient fee annually, semi-annually, quarterly, or daily. Reserved mooring fees shall be paid for a period of one year. All mooring fees, reserved or transient, are paid to the City and shall be paid in advance for the period prescribed.

The following schedule is effective at 12:01 AM the day immediately following passage of this ordinance.
