ORDINANCE 80-17

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STOPPING OR PARK-ING IN AREAS OFFICIALLY POSTED, PROVIDING FOR VEHICLE IMPOUND AND PENALTY.

CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 12-700.1. GENERAL.

It is the intent of this ordinance to regulate vehicular stopping or parking in certain areas where officially posted.

Section 12-700.2. STOPPING OR PARKING WHERE PROHIBITED.

A person may not stop or park a vehicle in a place or area where an official sign or traffic control device prohibits stopping or parking of a vehicle.

Section 12-700.3. SAME - SIZE LIMITATION.

- (a) A person may not stop or park a vehicle or a combination of vehicles in excess of 20 feet in length in those areas where a sign prohibits parking of vehicles or a combination of vehicles in excess of 20 feet.
- (b) A person may not stop or park a vehicle or a combination of vehicles in excess of 40 feet in length in those areas where a sign prohibits parking of vehicles or a combination of vehicles in excess of 40 feet.

Section 12-700.4. SAME - TIME LIMITATION.

Where an official sign specifies a maximum time a vehicle may be parked in a specified area, it shall be unlawful to leave a vehicle parked in that area longer than the time specified.

Section 12-700.5. VEHICLES SUBJECT TO IMPOUND.

A police officer may impound and remove a vehicle which is found to be in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance. The owner of record of an impounded vehicle is responsible for all costs incurred for impounding and removal of the vehicle.

Section 12-700.6. PENALTY.

The penalty for violating provisions of this Ordinance are the same as those listed in the State of Alaska Uniform Traffic Bail Schedule for violation 12 AAC 02.340 through 13 AAC 02.520.

Section 12-700.7. INCLUSION IN CITY CODE.

This ordinance shall be inserted in the Homer City Traffic Code, Chapter 12, Article 7.
