ORDINANCE 80-21

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT CERTAIN FORECLOSED PROPERTY IN THE POSSESSION OF THE CITY OF HOMER SHALL BE DESIGNATED FOR PUBLIC USE AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIFIC PUBLIC USE; FURTHER PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE HOMER CITY CODE UNDER SPECIAL AND LIMITED ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, there is a need for certain foreclosed properties to be utilized for public use, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public to employ these properties in the manner stated below

THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. DEDICATION: The following foreclosed property is hereby dedicated for public use by the City of Homer:
