ORDINANCE 81-9

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE VIII,  
CITY OF HOMER CODE OF ORDINANCES, REPEALING AND  
REENACTING SECTION 14.800.1, DEFINING THE REQUISITE  
PERMIT TO ACT IN PUBLIC USE RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

WHEREAS, the performance of excavation and construction  
work in or on public use right-of-ways requires a permit, and

WHEREAS, criteria for issuing that permit needs defining,

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 14.800.1 is hereby repealed and reenacted  
to read:

Section 14.800.1 ACTS WITHIN PUBLIC USE RIGHT-OF-WAYS -  
PERMIT REQUIRED.

(A) No person, firm or corporation shall perform any act  
within the dedicated public use right-of-ways which in any manner  
would alter the condition of these right-of-ways as they now exist  
or exist at the time of dedication within the City of Homer without  
first obtaining a written permit from the City Manager or his  
designee.

(B) A written description of the activity must be submitted  
for approval at the time of the request for permit. Such request  
shall describe justification for such activity and may require  
submittal and approval of plans and specifications for such activity.

Section 2. Section 14.800.1 is the only section affected by  
this amending ordinance.
