6 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A MUNICIPAL PARKS AND
7 RECREATION COMMISSION AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES
8 FOR APPOINTMENT AND TERMS OF MEMBERS AND THEIR
9 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROVIDING FOR
10 INCLUSION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN THE HOMER CITY
11 CODE.

12 THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

13 Section 1. PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION -
14 CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP.

15 There is hereby created the City of Homer Parks
16 and Recreation Advisory Commission, hereinafter referred to
17 as the Commission. Such Commission will be made up of five
18 (5) members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed
19 by the City Council. One member of the commission may be a
20 resident from outside the city.

21 A Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Commission
22 shall be selected annually and shall be elected from and
23 by the appointive members.

24 The Mayor and the City Manager shall serve as
25 consulting members of the Commission in addition to the
26 five appointive members, and may attend all meetings as
27 consultants, but shall have no vote.

28 Section 2. SAME - TERMS OF COMMISSION MEMBERS.

29 (a) Members of the First Commission shall be
30 appointed for the following terms:

- 31 1. Two members shall be appointed for three-year
32

1 terms.

2 2. Two members shall be appointed for two-year
3 terms.

4 3. One member shall be appointed for a one-year
5 term.

6 (b) At the end of the respective terms set forth
7 in subparagraph (a) of this section, members shall be appointed
8 for full three-year terms.

9 (c) Any Commissioner who shall have two (2)
10 successive unexcused absences shall be subject to removal by
11 the Commission by a majority vote of the members present.

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13 Section 3. PROCEEDINGS OF THE COMMISSION.

14 The Commission shall meet regularly once a month,
15 and at the call of the Chairman. Permanent records or
16 minutes shall be kept of Commission proceedings and such
17 minutes shall record the vote of each member upon every
18 question. Every decision or finding shall immediately be
19 filed in the office of the City Clerk, and shall be a public
20 record open to inspection by any person. Every decision or
21 finding shall be directed to the City Council at the earliest
22 possible date.

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24 Section 4. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE
25 COMMISSION.

26 (a) It shall be the duty of the Commission to act
27 in an advisory capacity to the City Manager and the City
28 Council on the problems and development of park and recreation
29 facilities within the City. Considerations of the Commission
30 may include existing facilities, possible future development
31 and recommendations on land use.

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1 (b) Any recommendation the Commission may have
2 regarding park and recreation facilities is to be directed
3 to the City Manager.

4 (c) The Commission shall consider any specific
5 proposal, problem or project as directed by the City Council.

6 (d) The City Council may at a future date expand
7 or withdraw duties and responsibilities of the Commission.

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9 Section 5. INCLUSION IN CITY CODE.

10 This ordinance shall be included as Article VII-A,
11 Chapter Five, of the Homer City Code.
