ORDINANCE 82-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19.08.030 OF THE
HOMER MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROHIBIT CAMPING IN
OTHER THAN DESIGNATED AREAS WITHIN THE CITY
AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF SUCH PROHIBITION.

WHEREAS, The City of Homer enacted Emergency Ordinance 82-17
August 24, 1982 which prohibits camping in other than designated
areas within the City,

AND WHEREAS, Emergency Ordinance 82-17 will expire 60 days
from the effective date of August 24, 1982,

AND WHEREAS, the Council feels it necessary to continue to
control the conditions which resulted in the enactment of
Emergency Ordinance 82-17 on a permanent basis,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 19.08.030 of the Homer Municipal Code is
amended to read:

19.08.030 Parking or camping prohibited; enforcement.

- (a) No person shall park any motor vehicle or camper
or otherwise camp on any City-owned or
City-controlled property where any official sign
prohibits parking or camping.
- (b) Camping, as defined in Section 19.08.020b of this
Chapter is prohibited in areas other than those so
designated by the City, except where campers
camping on private property have written
permission to do so from the property owner.
- (c) Persons who refuse to remove themselves and their
personal property from unregulated camping areas
upon request by an authorized representative of
the City of Homer shall be removed, together with
their personal property, from said areas using

such force as may be necessary under the
circumstances.
