ORDINANCE 83-12

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NEW SECTION TO  
TITLE 7, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, PERTAINING  
TO STARTING PARKED VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, regulations pertaining to starting parked  
vehicles were omitted from the re-draft of the Alaska State  
Traffic Regulations, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide regulations for an  
acceptable manner in which to start a parked vehicle,

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Starting Parked Vehicles

A. A person may not move onto a roadway, a  
vehicle which is stopped, standing or parked until the  
movement can be made with reasonable safety.

B. No person may accelerate a vehicle which is  
stopped, standing or parked on or along a street or which is  
entering a street so rapidly as to unnecessarily cause the  
tires to squeal or spin in such a manner as to throw sand,  
rocks or gravel or leave black marks on the road surface.

C. No person shall enter or drive upon any  
street in such a manner which causes the driver to lose  
control of the vehicle or causes the vehicle to "fishtail."

Section 2. Inclusion in the Homer City Code

Section 1. of this ordinance shall be incorporated  
in the Homer City Code as section 7.08.021, entitled  
Starting Parked Vehicles.


Section 3. Penalty

Violations under this ordinance shall be punishable under the general penalty provision of the Homer City Code section 1.16.010.
