ORDINANCE 83-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.08 OF THE HOMER MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 8.08.145 TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION FROM CHAPTER FOR BONA FIDE CHARITABLE AND CIVIC ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, it was the intention of the City Council in enacting Chapter 8.08 of the Homer Municipal Code to protect city residents from undue harassment and possible fraud as the result of uncontrolled commercial solicitation by itinerant and transient merchants, and

WHEREAS, in so doing, the Council did not intend to prevent or unduly restrict the activities of authorized and bona fide civic and charitable groups within the City,

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

1. Chapter 8.08. Itinerant and Transient Merchant's License, of the Homer Municipal Code, is amended by adding the following section:

Section 8.08.145 NONAPPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. The provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to a person who solicits funds for any purpose or disseminates information in connection with an authorized activity of a charitable, religious, political or civic organization of which that person is a member, adherent or representative provided that such activity is carried out in an orderly manner and in no way disturbs the peace or creates a public or private nuisance.


