ORDINANCE 83-2/

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1.74.010 OF THE HOMER MUNICIPAL CODE AS TO NUMBER AND STATUS OF MEMBERS OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the City to increase the number of the voting members of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 1.74.010 of the Homer Municipal Code is hereby amended to read:

There is created 1.74.010 Created--Membership. a. the City of Homer Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, hereinafter referred to as the Commission. Such Commission will be made up of five seven members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. One member of the Commission may be a resident from outside the city. and-one-member-of-the-Commission-shall-be-a-Homer-High School-senior.

b. A Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Commission shall be selected annually and shall be elected from and by the appointive members.

The Mayor, and the City Manager, and one Homer High School student selected by his or her government class, shall serve as consulting members of the Commission in addition to the five seven appointive members, and may attend and participate in all meetings as consultants, but shall have no vote.

Section 1.74.020 of the Homer Municipal Code Section 2. is amended to read:

Voting members of the Terms of members. a. 1.74.020 first Commission shall be appointed for the-following three

1.--Two-members-shall-be-appointed-for-three-year-terms; 2:--Two-members-shall-be-appointed-for-two-year-terms; 3. b. The member serving from Homer High School senior class shall be appointed to a one-year term.
