5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1.74.010 OF THE
6 HOMER MUNICIPAL CODE AS TO NUMBER AND STATUS OF
7 MEMBERS OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY
8 COMMISSION.

9 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the
10 City to increase the number of the voting members of the
11 Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission.

12 NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

13 Section 1. Section 1.74.010 of the Homer Municipal
14 Code is hereby amended to read:

15 1.74.010 Created--Membership. a. There is created
16 the City of Homer Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission,
17 hereinafter referred to as the Commission. Such Commission
18 will be made up of ~~five~~ seven members, who shall be appointed
19 by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. One member
20 of the Commission may be a resident from outside the city.
21 ~~and one member of the Commission shall be a Homer High
22 School senior.~~

23 b. A Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Commission
24 shall be selected annually and shall be elected from and by
25 the appointive members.

26 c. The Mayor, ~~and~~ the City Manager, and one Homer High
School student selected by his or her government class, shall
serve as consulting members of the Commission in addition to
the ~~five~~ seven appointive members, and may attend and participate
in all meetings as consultants, but shall have no vote.

Section 2. Section 1.74.020 of the Homer Municipal Code
is amended to read:

1.74.020 Terms of members. a. Voting members of the
first Commission shall be appointed for the following three
year terms.

1. ~~Two members shall be appointed for three-year terms;~~

2. ~~Two members shall be appointed for two-year terms;~~

3. b. The member serving from Homer High School senior
class shall be appointed to a one-year term.
