## ORDINANCE 84-15

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF AN ADDITIONAL TWO PERCENT TAX ON SALES, RENTS AND SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY OF HOMER CONTINGENT UPON THE SETTING OF THE MILL LEVY ON PROPERTY LOCATED THEREIN AT A MAXIMUM OF SIX MILLS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR REFERRAL TO THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH FOR COLLECTION.

WHEREAS, at a special election held April 24, 1984 the following proposition was voted upon by the residents of the City of Homer:

"Shall the City of Homer set the property tax mill levy at an annual rate of six mills or less and levy an additional two percent sales tax on all sales, rents and services within the City, except as the same may be otherwise exempted by law. The revenues from the sales tax will be placed in the general fund. Voter authorization for the two percent sales tax shall only remain in effect for those years that the City Council can set the property mill levy at six mills or less."

AND WHEREAS, the foregoing proposition received affirmative votes from the majority of those casting a ballot in the election of April 24, 1984.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Levy of Sales Tax. An additional consumer's sales tax in the amount of two percent (2%) is hereby levied by the City of Homer on all sales, rents and services within the City except as the same may be otherwise exempted by law.

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Section 2. Mill Rate Contingency. The sales tax enacted hereby shall remain in effect only in such years that the City Council sets the property mill levy at six (6) mill or less. In such years as the property mill levy exceeds six (6) mill, this sales tax levy shall not be in effect.

Section 3. Effective Date. The effective date of the sales tax enacted by this ordinance is July 1, 1984, to be in effect so long as the property mill levy remains at six (6) mills or less.

Section 4. Referral to Kenai Peninsula Borough for

Collection. Upon enactment, this ordinance shall be referred
to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for notification of tax
registrants within the City and for implementation of other
collection procedures as required by law.

Section 5. Borough Sales Tax Provisions Adopted by Reference. Those sections of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances applicable to the levy and collection of the foregoing sales tax are hereby incorporated by this reference and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

Section 6. <u>Insertion in Municipal Code</u>. This ordinance shall be appropriately numbered and added to the Homer Municipal Code.
