ORDINANCE 84-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE 10.12.040,  
ELECTRIC ENERGY RATE, AND 10.12.060, LABOR CHARGES,  
INCREASING THE RATES TO COVER THE COST OF PROVIDING  
THE SERVICES AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS: the rates charged Harbor users for electrical service and  
miscellaneous services do not cover the cost of these services, and

WHEREAS: electrical and labor charges have not been adjusted since  
1979:

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. HCC 10.12.040 Electric Energy Rates is hereby repealed and  
re-enacted to read:

10.12.040 Electric Energy Rate. a. Long-term energy use shall  
be charged a flat rate of three dollars and fifty cents per month  
plus an electrical usage charge of thirteen cents per kilowatt.

b. The flat fee of three dollars and fifty cents shall be  
charged to each person having long-term electrical service  
available whether energy is used or not.

c. Transient vessels shall be charged a flat rate per  
twenty-four hour period of four dollars for 110V service and six  
dollars for 220V service.

d. Vessels utilizing the wood or commercial grid shall be  
charged thirteen cents per kilowatt of electrical energy usage.

Section 2. HCC 10.12.060 Labor Charges is hereby repealed and re-enacted  
to read:

10.12.060 Labor Charges. All work performed by the  
Harbormaster as a result of an emergency or as a result of the  
owner or operator of any vessel making a request to the  
Harbormaster shall be charged for at the rate of thirty dollars  
per hour with a minimum charge of one hour plus costs for use of  
city equipment and any additional direct costs incurred by the  
City while performing such. (Prior code 7-300.8).

Section 3. The effective date of the amendments shall be ~~June 20~~ <sup>July 1</sup>, 1984. *Kgh*

Section 4. HCC Sections 10.12.040 and 10.12.060 are the only sections affected by the amendment.
