ORDINANCE 84-33

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HOMER, ALASKA, REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING CHAPTER
21.60.010 REGARDING SIGN STANDARDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer currently regulates signs and
advertising devices as governed by the Homer Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the existing sign code section has not been amended for
several years; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission has spent
considerable time and effort to revise the sign code ordinance and
address certain deficiencies; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission has conducted a
public hearing on the proposed sign code on November 7, 1984 and held
a special meeting on November 16, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission recommends
adoption of this sign code to the Homer City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1: HMC 21.60.010 is hereby repealed and re-enacted to
read as attached.
