WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission recommends adoption of this sign code to the Homer City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1: HMC 21.60.010 is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as attached.
