ORDINANCE 86-30

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL MAINTENANCE MAP OF  
THE CITY OF HOMER BY ADDING HEATH STREET AND TRITON  
COURT.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer has determined that it is necessary to  
provide minimum standards to regulate design and construction of public  
streets, roads and highways within the City; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 85-14 adopted July 2, 1985 provides appropriate  
street design and construction standards as well as an official maintenance  
map to record streets officially accepted for maintenance; and

WHEREAS, such ordinance also provides that the City shall not  
accept maintenance responsibility for any road or street which is not  
constructed or reconstructed to the adopted standards unless the road is shown  
on the Official Maintenance Map of the City of Homer; and


WHEREAS, Heath Street (Station 10+00 north to Station 18+50) and  
Triton Court (Station 3+50 to Station 6+20) have been inspected, reviewed and  
approved by the Public Works Department and recommended for acceptance of  
maintenance by the City.

BE IT ORDAINED:


Section 1. Section 11.04.055 Official Maintenance Map - Adopted is  
amended per provisions of Sections a through e to include the following  
additional streets for permanent maintenance by the City of Homer and recorded  
as Amendment #5 and Amendment #6 on the Official Maintenance Map:

- #5 Heath Street, 850 linear feet or 0.161 mile
- #6 Triton Court, 270 linear feet or 0.051 mile
