ORDINANCE 87-29

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA, AMENDING CHAPTER 3.16 OF THE HOMER MUNICIPAL CODE.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Homer ordains:

- Section 1. Section 3.16.030 Open Market procedures is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read as follows:
- A. Purchases or contracts authorized by Section 3.16.010 having an estimated value in excess of five thousand dollars but less than fifteen thousand dollars may be made in the open market without newspaper advertisement.
- B. Purchases greater than five thousand dollars but less than fifteen thousand dollars shall, whenever practical, be based on at least two competitive bids submitted in writing and shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.
- C. Small procurements greater than five hundred dollars but less than five thousand dollars shall, whenever practical, be based on at least two price quotations.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The Procurement Policy and Procedure Manual referenced in Section 3.16.010 is hereby replaced by Revision No. 1 of the Manual.
