ORDINANCE 88-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ANIMALS OF THE HOMER MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 20.08.020 ANIMALS ON THE HARBOR FLOATS.

WHEREAS, changes in the the Port/Harbor Regulations Ordinance made it necessary to also change the Animal Control ordinance to reflect the control on animals in the harbor;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 20.08.020, Animals on harbor floats is hereby amended to read as follows:


20.08.020 Animals on harbor floats. No person shall have, in his possession, keep, or maintain, any animal on the floats of the Homer Small Boat Harbor, [without first obtaining permission, in writing, from the Harbormaster. Individuals obtaining such permission will be required to restrain the animal at all times and will] unless the animal is kept under physical control by leash or chain at all times. The person in control of the animal shall be responsible for the clean up of the animal's excrements and litter caused by the animal. [on the harbor floats.] Failure to properly clean up after the animal will result in appropriate clean up labor charges (minimum of 1/2 hour) being assessed against the owner and/or person in control of the animal. Penalty: Class A infraction. (Ord. 79-10 1, 1979: prior code 20-100.16)




