

CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA
ORDINANCE NO. 89-25

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING TITLE 4,
SECTION 4.04.070, VOTER QUALIFICATIONS,
PURSUANT TO AS 29.26.050

WHEREAS, the First Session of the 16th Alaska Legislature enacted SB 173, effective August 30, 1989, and thereby amended voter qualifications for state and municipal elections; and,

WHEREAS, the state amendment supersedes local code provisions; and,

WHEREAS, the state has sought and obtained Federal Department of Justice preclearance for the amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Title 4, Section 4.04.070, is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

4.04.070 Voter qualifications. A person may vote in a municipal election only if the person:

- a. is qualified to vote in state elections under AS 15.05.010;
- b. has been a resident of the municipality for 30 days immediately preceding the election;
- c. is registered to vote in state elections at a residence address within the municipality at least 30 days before the municipal election at which the person seeks to vote; and
- d. is not disqualified under Article V of the State Constitution.


Section 2. This ordinance becomes effective on the day following enactment, pursuant to § 1.08.030 of the Homer City Code.


