ORDINANCE 92-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE CHAPTER 8.08,
ITINERANT OR TRANSIENT MERCHANT'S LICENSE, AND
CHAPTER 8.11, MOBILE FOOD SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the internal parity study of the Public Library and City Hall, acknowledged by Council with the City Manager directed to implement via Resolution 90-53 on July 23, 1990, stated that the Itinerant or Transient Merchant Licensing and Mobile Food Service Licensing would fall under the purview of the City Planning Department rather than the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Department has been conducting this service since that time. It is the recommendation of Administration that Homer City Code Chapters 8.08 and 8.11, which make specific reference to the City Clerk, be amended eliminating all reference to the City Clerk and inserting City Planner or designee.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. That all reference to the City Clerk be deleted and reference to the City Planner or designee be inserted in the following sections and/or subsections.

8.08.030, Itinerant or transient merchant license--
Application.

8.08.040(d), Referral--Fees.

8.08.110, Report of convictions for chapter violations.

8.11.030, License--Required. (Mobile Food Service)

8.11.040 (a) & (b), License--Application--Contents.
