ORDINANCE NO. 92-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA,
AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2
AND HOMER CITY CODE TITLE 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS,
CONCERNING ADOPTION AND AMENDMENT OF A CITY CODE

WHEREAS, on February 23, 1982, the Homer City Council enacted Ordinance 82-2, adopting a recodification of the 1967 Homer City Code; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of Ordinance 82-2 have never been codified; and,

WHEREAS, although some of the provisions of Ordinance 82-2 have, in effect, been superseded by the enactment of a more recently enacted ordinance (specifically, Section 5 thereof has effectively been amended by Ordinance 90-21 § 1, codified at § 1.04.065 of the Code), some provisions of the ordinance remain in effect and have no corresponding counterpart in the existing Homer City Code; and,

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to clarify the status of the specific provisions of Ordinance 82-2 and to amend certain provisions due to changing circumstances since adoption of the ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 82-2 and Homer City Code § 1.04.010 are hereby repealed and re-enacted as § 1.01.010, to read as follows:

1.01.010 Designation and citation of code.
The ordinances included in the following titles, chapters, articles, and sections constitute and are designated as the "Code of Ordinances, City of Homer, Alaska," and may be so cited. This Code may also be cited as the "Homer City Code" or "HCC".

Section 2. Section 3 of Ordinance 82-2 shall be codified as Homer City Code § 1.04.055 and is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.04.055 Amendments to code. A. Any and all ordinances enacted by the City Council that add to, amend, or repeal provisions of additions or amendments to this the Homer City Code when passed in such form as to indicate the intention of the City Council to make the same part thereof, shall be deemed to be incorporated in such Code as of the effective date of each ordinance so that reference to the "Homer Municipal Code" this Code shall be understood and intended to include such ordinances additions and amendments.

B. All ordinances enacted subsequent to adoption of this Code that add to, amend, or repeal provisions of this Code may be numbered in accordance with the numbering system of this Code and printed in supplemental form for inclusion herein. In the case of repealed titles, chapters, articles, sections, subsections, or any part thereof, by subsequent ordinances, such repealed portions may be excluded from the Code by omission from reprinted pages affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 4 of Ordinance 82-2 is hereby numbered as Homer City Code § 1.01.020 and amended to read as follows:


1.01.020 Public copy of code. A. A copy of this Code shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk. It shall be the express duty of the City Clerk, or someone authorized by the Clerk the Clerk's designee, to shall insert in their designated places all amendments or ordinances which that indicate the intention of the City Council to make the same a part of such Code, and to extract from such Code all provisions which that may be from time to time repealed by the City Council. This copy of such Code shall be available for all persons desiring to examine the same, at the Homer City Offices office of the City Clerk, during the regular business hours.

B. Copies of this Code and supplements thereto shall be made available for sale to the public at a price to be determined by the City Council.

Section 4. This ordinance is a general ordinance of a permanent nature and provisions of Section 1 through Section 3 of this ordinance shall be codified for inclusion in the Homer City Code.
