ORDINANCE 94-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING § 14.04.040 OF THE CITY CODE TO ESTABLISH SEWER RATES FOR CUSTOMERS OUTSIDE OF CITY BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 93-19(A) was adopted on October 11, 1993 and effective October 12, 1993, which provides the authority for the City of Homer to extend sewer service outside the City boundaries and to regulate the same; and

WHEREAS, 14.04.105(h) (Ord. 93-19(A)) states that the City may charge higher rates to customers outside the City boundaries than to customers inside the City boundaries; and

WHEREAS, HCC § 14.04.040 sewer rate schedule currently addresses only sewer users within the City limits and in the Kachemak City LID; and

WHEREAS, Council requested at the November 8, 1993 Regular meeting that sewer customers outside City boundaries be charged an increased rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. HCC § 14.04.040 is hereby amended by adding subparagraph (f) to read as follows:

(f) Charges for sewer utility services to customers outside city boundaries shall be the following as listed as a temporary rate schedule until the next Cost of Service Study, except for members of the Kachemak City Local Improvement District whose rate is established by § HCC 14.04.040 (d).

Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included in the City Code.
