AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE SECTION 10.18.230, SEAFOOD

WHEREAS, Homer City Code 10.20.010 states that an annual review shall be required of the Port, Fish Dock and Harbor rates; and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council in 1991 began amending the Homer City Code, as needed, providing for the authorization to set rates via Resolution.

WHEREAS, Section 10.18.230 of the Homer City Code does not specify that current wharfage fees are for seafood processed within the boundaries of the City of Homer; and

WHEREAS, Section 10.18.230 of the Homer City Code does not address wharfage fees for seafood processed outside the boundaries of the City of Homer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HOMER:

Section 1. That the Homer City Code 10.18.230, Seafood, is hereby amended to read as follows:

All seafood and seafood products will be assessed a wharfage fee of two dellars-and-fifty cents per ton or fraction thereof, set by City Council Resolution.

Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included in the City Code.
