

ORDINANCE 95-9

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER,
ALASKA AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE SECTION
10.18.220, PORT TARIFF RATES AND REGULATIONS,
LOGS, WOODEN.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HOMER:

Section 1. That the Homer City Code §10.18.220, Logs, wooden,
is hereby amended to read as follows:

Logs, in lots of two hundred fifty thousand feet board
measure, outbound only:

a. Two dollars per one thousand board feet measure in 1995.
Two dollars and fifty cents per one thousand board feet measure in
1996.

b. In absence of board feet measure on bill of lading, ~~three
pounds will equal one board foot measure.~~ a loadout will be
assessed a tariff by converting the weight of logs to board foot
measure, for the average diameter of logs (small end diameter) in
accordance with the following table for white spruce logs:

| <u>Scaling Diameter of Logs</u> <u>Inches</u> | <u>Weight per Board Feet</u> <u>Pounds</u> |
|--|---|
| <u>8"</u> | <u>14.5</u> |
| <u>12"</u> | <u>11.5</u> |
| <u>16"</u> | <u>9.5</u> |
| <u>20"</u> | <u>8.5</u> |
| <u>24"</u> | <u>7.8</u> |

Kiln dried lumber: three pounds will equal one board foot measure.


Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general



