ORDINANCE 95 - 25(4)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING SECTION 21.44.020 (bb) TO ALLOW RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS AS A PERMITTED USE THROUGHOUT THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT

WHEREAS, recreational vehicle parks are currently allowed only in specific areas of the Central Business District; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission initiated this ordinance to allow recreational vehicle parks throughout the Central Business District; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on this matter on June 7, 1995, as required by City Code.

NOW THEREFORE, ~~BE IT RESOLVED~~ BY THE CITY OF HOMER:
BE IT ORDAINED

Section 1. Homer City Code 21.48.020 (bb) is hereby revised to read as follows:

~~bb. Recreational vehicle parks may be located south of the Sterling Highway (Homer Bypass) from Lake Street west to the boundary of the central business district abutting Webber Subdivision, and from Heath Street to the west side of Lakeside Village Subdivision, provided they shall conform to the standards in 21.61.090.~~

Section 2. This ordinance is a permanent and general character and shall be included in the City Code.
