AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING SECTION 21.44.020 (bb) TO ALLOW RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS AS A PERMITTED USE THROUGHOUT THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT

WHEREAS, recreational vehicle parks are currently allowed only in specific areas of the Central Business District; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission initiated this ordinance to allow recreational vehicle parks throughout the Central Business District; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on this matter on June 7, 1995, as required by City Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HOMER: BE IT ORDHINED

Section 1. Homer City Code 21.48.020 (bb) is hereby revised to read as follows:

bb. Recreational vehicle parks-may-be-located south-of-the Sterling-Highway-(Homer-Bypass)-from-bake-Street-west-to-the boundary-of-the-central-business-district-abutting-Webber Subdivision,-and from-Heath-Street-to-the-west-side-of bakeside-Village Subdivision, provided they shall conform to the standards in 21.61.090.

Section 2. This ordinance is a permanent and general character and shall be included in the City Code.
