AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1996 FOR THE GENERAL FUND, THE WATER FUND, THE SEWER FUND, THE PORT/HARBOR FUND, THE AIRPORT FUND, DEBT FUNDS, CAPITAL RESERVED FUNDS (CONDITIONAL EXPENDITURES).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The 1996 Budget is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The following appropriations are made for calendar year 1996:

Section 3. Appoint a Task Force to be named the Homer Centennial Committee, whose job it would be to come up with a plan to celebrate Homer's 100th Anniversary and the budget.

Section 4. A copy of the budget shall be certified by the City Clerk and filed in the Office of the City Clerk.

Section 5. This ordinance is limited to approval of the budget and appropriations for fiscal year 1996 and shall not be included in the City Code.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1996.


