WHEREAS, Mayor Gregoire issued a veto of Ordinance 95-32(A), 1996 Calendar Year Budget and Resolution 95-102, 1996 Calendar Year Line Item Budget; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriations are required for the operation of the City for the first part of 1996, until Council can take action regarding this veto.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The emergency January 1 through 12, 1996 appropriations are hereby adopted as follows:

Reserve Funds (Conditional Expenditures)	\$ 23,392
