Section 2. A new subsection HCC 21.32.158 is hereby added to the		
Homer City Code to read as follows:		
21.32.158 Drive-in car wash. "Drive-in car wash" means automated		
car wash facilities and equipment used for retail car wash services. Said drive- in car wash shall be enclosed within a permanent building and may be

accompanied by vacuum cleaning equipment for car interior detailing outside		
of the building.
