AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER,
ALASKA AMENDING THE HOMER CITY CODE SECTION
1.24.040, BY-LAWS FOR COUNCIL PROCEDURE,
SUBSECTION (M) SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Homer City Code Section 1.24.040(m) is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.24.040 By-Laws for Council Procedures.

m. Salaries of elected officials:

The Council may fix by ordinance the salaries of elected officials. The Mayor and Homer City Council shall receive an expense allowance of ~~\$50.00~~ \$100.00 per month meeting and \$100.00 per day for out of town lobbying efforts as directed by Council. An elected official may not receive any other compensation for service to the municipality unless specifically authorized to do so by ordinance. Per diem payments or reimbursements for expenses are not compensation under this section.

Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included in the City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance will become effective January 1, 1999.
