12	Section 1. A new Chapter 8.02, entitled General Business License, is hereby
13	added to the Homer City Code to read as follows:

16	business in the city, a person shall first obtain a business license and pay the
17	prescribed license fee. A separate license shall be obtained for each separate
18	business name under which the person does business in the city. A license
19	covers all of the business operations in the city conducted under the business
20	name indicated on the license, regardless of the number of its establishments.

22	b. A person engaging in a business subject to other licensing provisions
23	under this code must, in addition to obtaining the license required by this
24	section, comply with those other licensing provisions before engaging in
25	business in the city.

27	8.02.020 Business license - application. A person shall apply for a
28	business license on forms prescribed by the city manager. The application
29	must include:
30	1. the name and address of the licensee;

97	3. refuses or fails to produce a business license for inspection upon the
98	request of any person entitled to inspect it.
99	4. fails to prominently display the business license in the licensee's
100	business location in the city or to carry the license on the person if the licensee
101	has no fixed business location in the city.
102	5. violates any regulation adopted to implement this chapter.

104	b. The civil penalty for a violation of subparagraph (a) of this section
105	may not exceed \$100 the first time a civil penalty is assessed, \$200 for a
106	second assessment, \$\(\frac{1}{2}\) \cdot \(\frac{1}{2}\) for a third assessment, and \$1,000 for a fourth or
107	subsequent assessment.

113	8.02.100 Definitions. In this chapter, unless the context otherwise
114	requires:

116	"business" means a for profit or nonprofit entity or person engaging or
117	offering to engage in a trade, a service, a profession, or an activity with the goal
118	of receiving a financial benefit in exchange for the provision of services, or
119	goods, or other property.
120	
121	"fisheries business" means a business that engages in processing
122	fisheries resources.
123	
124	"fisheries resources" has the same meaning as in 15 AAC 75.300.
125	"·····································
126 127	"person" has the same meaning as in Section 1.04.020.
127	"munagaing fighaning magazungas" magaz any activity that we differ an
129	"processing fisheries resources" means any activity that modifies or
130	preserves the physical condition of a fisheries resource, including without
131	limitation, butchering, freezing, salting, cooking, canning, dehydrating, smoking, decapitating, gutting, gilling, sliming, icing, or other activities
132	performed in preparing fisheries resources for further processing, for
133	subsequent sale, or to maintain the quality of the fresh resource, regardless of
134	whether the processor owns the fisheries resources and regardless of whether
135	the processor is the seller in the subsequent sale of the fisheries resources.
136	Notwithstanding the foregoing, "processing fisheries resources" does not
137	include decapitating shrimp and gutting, gilling, sliming, or icing a fisheries
138	resource solely for the purpose of maintaining the quality of the fresh resource
139	when done by a licensed commercial fisherman on the commercial fishing
140	vessel that caught the fisheries resources.
141

143	Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be
144	included in the City code.
