WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Humanities, while reviewing an application for partial funding of this construction, is concerned with the operational impact of this project on museum programs; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to assist the Society in its fund raising endeavors for this project;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council supports the basic operational and maintenance needs of the Phase II expansion of the Pratt Museum.
