RESOLUTION 84-43

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO CONDUCT OF THE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, the authority of the Homer City Council is superior to that of Mayor Erle Cooper, (AS 29.23.240) (Reherd v. Manders, 11 Alaska 48, 66F. Supp. 520, D Alas. 1946); and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has considered a Resolution of Censure (83-65, 28 Nov 83) against Mayor Erle Cooper regarding conduct unbecoming his office, which Resolution resulted in a 3-3 tie vote in Council with the Mayor himself casting the deciding nay voice; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Erle Cooper has since conducted himself in an increasingly unbecoming, noxious, and embarrassing fashion, especially regarding unwarranted chastisements of City employees and inadvisable complaints to the press; and

WHEREAS, such conduct by this Mayor or any other Mayor must cease and desist if the City of Homer is to enjoy an honorable reputation devoid of maladroit and inexcusable malfeasances of conduct;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council:

THAT, Mayor Erle Cooper is hereby censured and reprimanded in a manner stronger and more serious than that contemplated for the previous Resolution; and
