RESOLUTION 84-44

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO STREAMLINING OF CITY ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, it is the mandated duty (AS 29.48.010) of the Homer City Council to promulgate resolutions and ordinances defining how the City administration shall be organized and managed; and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has repeatedly expressed its collective and individual support for streamlining and minimizing the City administration's impact upon the citizenry; and

WHEREAS, numerous complaints have been received by the Homer City Council members from concerned taxpayers about the burgeoning City bureaucracy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT, pursuant to its mandated authority (AS 29,48.130), the Homer City Council does hereby abolish the City functions and/or offices of Animal Control, and Cemetery; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

THAT, such functions be returned to the private sector of the economy via an advertised, competitive bid-and-contract process to be designed and managed by the Homer City Manager with final approval by the Homer City Council, at all deliberate speed.
