A RESOLUTION FINDING THE NEED FOR A SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ON HANSEN AVENUE, AND FINDING SUFFICIENCY OF THE PETITION REQUESTING SUCH DISTRICT AND SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, a petition representing owners of more than one half in value of property on Hansen Avenue has been received requesting a sewer improvement district, and,

WHEREAS, there is no sewer system to these lots at present, however, the City sewer system can be made available, and it is in the interest of the good health of the area to have the sewer system, and,

WHEREAS, the signatures represent a legally sufficient number of the property owners whose property values exceed one half of the value of the property to be benefitted,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska, that the Council does determine that the improvement is necessary and that it is determined that the requests meet the requirements of the Homer City Code and the Alaska Statutes in that the legally required number of property owners signed in favor of the district,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intent of the City of Homer to form such improvement district as requested and that a Public Hearing will be held on Monday, July 23, 1984, at Homer City Hall, at 7:30 P.M., for the purpose of hearing protests to the formation of such improvement district,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to compile the necessary information on the cost of the improvement and to begin to prepare plans for the improvement to notify the property owners of such cost and the date of the hearing and to have notice of the hearing published as required by law.
