Pursuant to its mandated authority (AS 29.48.130), the Homer City Council does hereby request examination of Homer City Government functions relating to streamlining of administration and staffing,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such functions that can be returned to the private sector of the economy via an advertised, competitve bid-and contract process to be designed and managed by the Homer City Manager with final approval by the Homer City Council be determined.
