RESOLUTION 84-68

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE AWARD OF THE BARTLETT STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT FROM DEITZ ALASKA CONSTRUCTION AND AWARDING THE BARTLETT STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT TO ARNDT BROTHERS FOR THE UNIT PRICE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$15,755 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer held a public bid opening for the Bartlett Street Sidewalk project on June 5, 1984 at 10:00 a.m. at the Homer City Hall; and,

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder for the project was the firm of Deitz Alaska Construction, who was awarded the contract by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska on June 11, 1984; and,

WHEREAS, Deitz Alaska Construction is unable to provide the required performance and payment bonds within the specified time frame; and,

WHEREAS, Arndt Brothers is the apparent second low responsive bidder;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the award of the Bartlett Street Sidewalk project to Deitz Alaska Construction be rescinded and the Deitz Alaska Construction bid bond in the amount of \$1,035.50 be forfeited to the City of Homer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract for the Bartlett Street Sidewalk project be awarded in the amount of \$15,755.00 to Arndt Brothers and that the City Manager be authorized to sign the appropriate documents.
